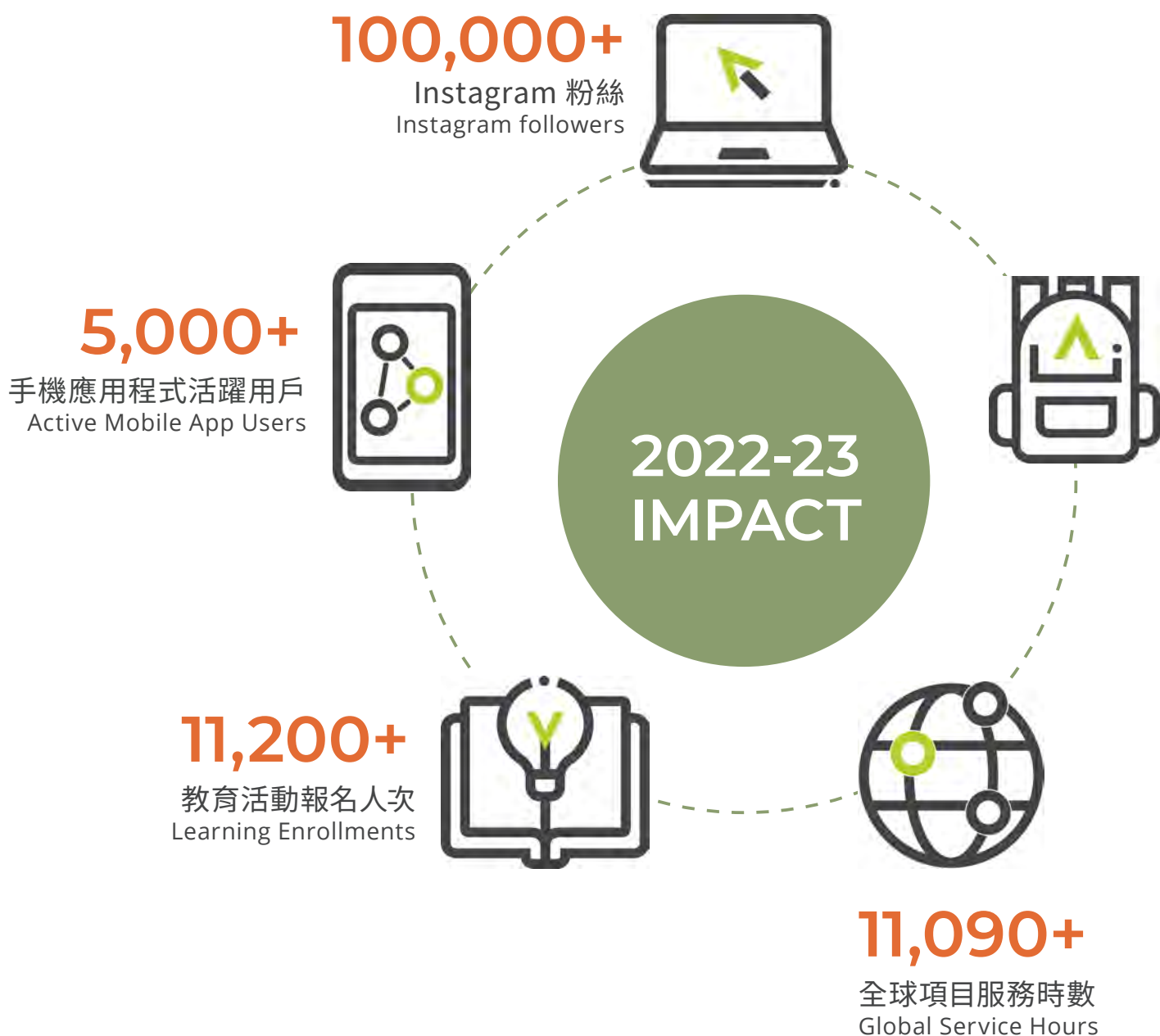

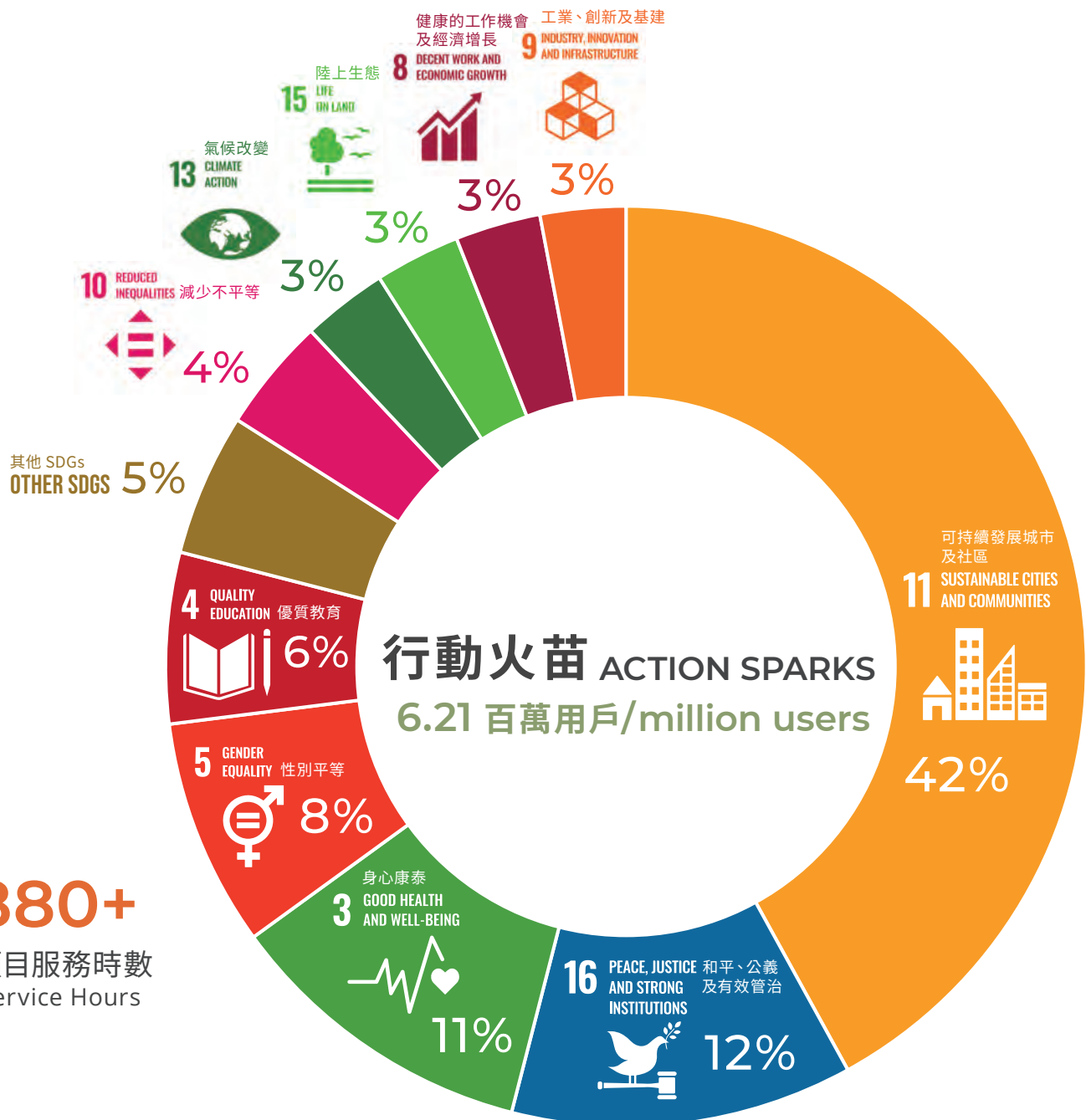

新冠疫情挑戰了全球人們的思維和行為方式。在這個困難的時期，義遊通過靈活運用科技進步，成功使我們的项目、資金來源和影響力更多元化，這些改變為義遊及社區帶來重大而長遠的影響。

COVID has challenged the way people think and act globally. During this difficult period, Voltra has successfully diversified our programmes, funding sources, and impact by manoeuvring technological advancement. These changes brought substantial and long-lasting impacts to Voltra and the community.

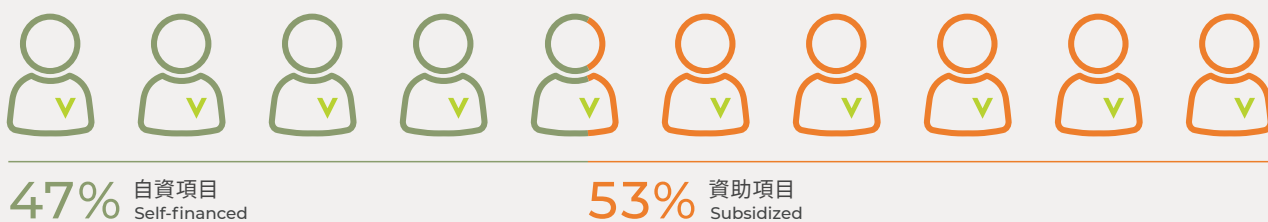
本年度，義遊透過社交媒體 Instagram 推出不同具教育和互動性的內容，成功累積超過 10 萬名粉絲，同時啟發超過 600 萬用戶，以不同形式參與義遊的線上活動，從中吸收不同領域的知識，推動不同的可持續發展議程，其中以「可持續城市和社區」、「和平、正義和強大機構」和「健康及福祉」成果最為顯著。最後，隨著疫情舒緩，義遊一貫的全球行動亦漸漸重上軌道，自資和資助的參加者人數分別超過 5000 及 3500 人。社會邁向全面復常，我們期待有關項目進一步發展，擴大義遊的影響力。

This year, Voltra has launched a wide range of educational and interactive content on its Instagram platform. These efforts have garnered over 100,000 cumulative followers. Additionally, Voltra has successfully inspired more than 6 million users to actively engage with its online activities, resulting in the acquisition of diverse knowledge. Voltra's initiatives have had a significant impact on fostering discussions regarding sustainability, particularly on topics such as "Sustainable Cities and Communities," "Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions," and "Good Health and Well-being". As the effects of the pandemic gradually subside, Voltra has resumed its usual global programs. These programs have attracted 5,000 self-financed participants and 3,500 subsidized participants respectively. We expect these programmes to further develop in the near future.

International Workcamp Return

國際工作營回歸

隨著新冠疫情放緩，社會復常，義遊一貫的國際工作營亦重新開始，為參加者提供到世界各地參與義工行動的機會，幫助他們擴闊眼界，體驗文化交流與碰撞，從而反思自身所處的社區，勇於作出改變。

As the COVID pandemic subsides, Voltra gradually resumed its usual international workcamps, providing participants a chance to experience volunteering in different places, enhancing their scope and facilitating cultural exchange. These experiences prompt participants to reflect upon their own society and initiate changes they want to see.

我開頭覺得有小小孤獨㗎，同埋本身我又比較被動，唔係好識點樣帶話題。但係嗰度d英國人好nice好pure，佢哋會同你傾下人生價值觀，音樂，藝術，天文等等好多野。傾傾下你會發現個世界真係好大，同埋朋友不分界線年齡人種社會地位，甚至乎我喺嗰度認識左d忘年之交。

去到嗰度都係我第一次露營，好多野都要自己處理，慢慢變得獨立可以照顧自己。然而我地進行volunteering既時候其實都要學習點樣係一個群體裡面與人相處，唔係自己一腳踢。本來因為一d文化差異令我同一d teammate產生阻隔，但後來我地溝通之後發現彼此既問題，所以我地就和解左，好感恩。

I felt a little lonely at first as I was relatively passive and not sure how to drive conversations. But the British are very nice and pure. They will share with you their values of life, music, art, astronomy, etc. I later realised that the world is really big. There are no boundaries to set apart friends of different age, race and social status. I even made friends who were a lot older than me!

It was also my first time camping and handling different situations in the wild on my own. I gained independence through the experience. By contrast, we had to learn how to work as a team while volunteering. I thought that cultural differences might be a barrier among volunteers. Fortunately, such problems were resolved after communicating with each other. I was very grateful.

I was almost moved to tears! How often would one see such a spectacle in life! We stayed there for around two hours, busy shooting photos with our big lenses. Our hands were frozen by the wind and the chill. It was past 11pm while we hit home but it was all worth it.

If I have to use one word to describe this work camp, it'd be "wonderful". When I watched hundreds of baby turtles returning to the sea, it was like a dream come true for me. I'm glad to have created this beautiful memory.

I was a volunteer at our group workcamp. There were 3 people from Italy, 2 people from Japan, and 1 person from Mexico. Even though everyone was not good at English, we tried hard to communicate. 🗣️Through communication, I have learnt more about other countries. For example, the staple food of Italians is pasta. They eat it at least once a day. 🍝

It turns out that Italian and Spanish (spoken by Mexicans) are similar in many ways. So Italians can all understand a bit of Spanish. Everyone has a different attitude towards life. Europeans are generally more chill. 😌

I learnt about all these after knowing the others for a while. The Japanese are not always punctual as stereotyped. The two Japanese in my team were very cool. 🇯🇵

I had no problem drinking with the locals. Our friends in Mexico taught us how to play Mexican games, helped us translate around and brought us to different places. 😊

A huge benefit of participating in a workcamp is to meet people from different countries. And learn about everyone's culture and habits.

活動摘要 Project Summary

香港賽馬會社區資助計劃-義地領袖學院：特義公民2022旨在讓參加者探索香港不同社群的獨特生活文化，帶著好奇和包容，以少數群體的角度重新認識香港。參加者參與線上線下活動，結識來自不同背景的同道中人，分成隊伍參加一系列任務，挑戰自己、展開探索，從中體驗日常較少接觸的少數族裔社群及其生活方式，走進「在地異域」，從而「看見世界」。最後，參加者更共同建立任務推廣文化共融，踏出Glocal Action第一步。

The Hong Kong Jockey Club Community Project Grant – Glocal Leader Academy: Glocal Hero 2022 aims to allow participants to explore the unique cultural life of different communities in Hong Kong, approaching it with curiosity and inclusiveness, and reacquaint themselves with Hong Kong from the perspective of minority groups. Participants engage in online and offline activities, meet like-minded individuals from diverse backgrounds, form teams to undertake various missions, challenge themselves, and embark on exploration. Through this experience, they learn about the lifestyles of ethnic minority communities that they may have had limited exposure to, stepping into the "local exotic" and "seeing the world". Finally, participants collaborate in establishing missions to promote cultural integration, taking the first step towards Glocal Action.

活動摘要 Project Summary

得到香港賽馬會慈善信託基金，義遊得以跟不同的社企夥伴合作，提供多個見習機會，讓有志回饋社會的年輕人參與超過60小時本地特別工種體驗，透過實戰深入了解社企運作，培養「未來技能」(future skills)。為擴闊受惠社群，本計劃接受在學及在職人士參與，提供彈性地點及時間安排。透過此項活動，參加者不但獲得寶貴的工作經驗，更親身體驗籌備不同項目的困難，亦藉此擴闊了人際圈子，認識志同道合的朋友，對於日後籌劃和實踐個人理念有很大幫助。

With the support of the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust, VolTra has partnered with various social enterprises to provide multiple internship opportunities, which allow young people to participate in over 60 hours of local special work experiences. Through practical experience, participants gain a deeper understanding of social enterprise operations and develop their "future skills." To expand the beneficiary community, this program accepts participation from students and working professionals, offering flexible locations and time arrangements. Through this program, participants have gained invaluable work experience and have had the opportunity to firsthand experience the challenges involved in planning and executing programs. In addition, they have had the chance to connect with like-minded individuals who will continue to inspire and contribute to the implementation of their own conceptualisation of social programmes. These connections will serve as a valuable support network, fostering ongoing growth and development in their respective fields.

活動摘要 Project Summary

得到滙豐銀行資助，是次計劃分兩階段進行。第一階段，義遊聯同不同社區伙伴舉辦一系列文化團文化導賞團，讓參加者參觀不同行業及社區(例如：古老工藝、參觀不同族裔宗教場所等)，以嶄新角度探索社區。參加者隨後接受一系列有關社區文化的任務挑戰，探索社區的需要。在第二階段中，計劃邀請經驗豐富的社區行動策劃者，分享他們的行動初衷以及設計意念，帮助大家掌握任務設計的目的及方向，專業導師更加親自教授不同主題的特訓班課程，從社交媒體經營到設計遊戲的心法，幫助參加者累積全方面的技能，提升個人競爭力。最後，參加者與新認識的隊友一起挑戰最終任務，遊歷社區，將所學的技能實踐出來，發掘社區的無限可能。

With the funding of HSBC, this program is divided into two stages. In the first stage, VolTra collaborates with various community partners to organize a series of cultural guided tours to different industries and communities (such as traditional crafts and visits to places of diverse ethnic and religious backgrounds) to explore the community from fresh perspectives. Participants then undertake a series of mission challenges related to community culture, exploring the needs of the community. In the second stage, the program invites experienced community action planners to share their motivations and design ideas, helping participants grasp the purpose and direction of mission design. Professional mentors also personally instruct specialized training courses on various topics, ranging from social media management to the art of game design, helping participants accumulate comprehensive skills and enhance their competitiveness. Finally, participants, together with their newly acquainted teammates, embark on the ultimate mission to explore the community, putting their learned skills into practice and discovering the infinite possibilities within the community.

活動摘要 Project Summary

「賽馬會鼓掌・創你程計劃」是一個協助青少年生涯規劃的計劃，透過提升他們的價值、態度、技能及知識，啟發他們對生涯規劃的想像。在此框架下，義遊為參加者策劃了為期十四天的網上挑戰體驗，參加者組成不同隊伍，利用 Goodmate 平台，完成不同任務，學習不同技能，接觸多元群體，擴闊視野。其後，參加者再參加兩日一夜實體學習營，透過活動鍛鍊同理心，又透過真人圖書館，從社區 Change Maker 身上獲取提升自我的啟發。

Clap@JC aims to aid young individuals in their career planning journey by enriching their values, attitudes, skills, and knowledge, thereby enriching their career and life planning. Under this framework, Voltra organized a 14-day online challenge experience. Participants were put into different teams to accomplish different tasks on the Goodmate app which Voltra developed. Through that, they acquired diverse skills, engaged with different groups, and expanded their horizons. Subsequently, a two-day-one-night physical learning camp was held, promoting empathy through activities. The camp also provided access to a human library, allowing participants to be inspired by community Change Makers.

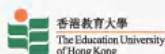
「滙豐香港社區夥伴計劃」期望透過不同地區的活動，推動社區共融。義遊在2022年首次成為「社區創科編程馬拉松」統籌機構，以提升社區抗逆力為出發點，旨在啟發同學們在創科領域方面的創意，協助不同社群發展專業技能及軟技能。比賽分為三個組別，包括「未來技能」、「身心健康」以及「綠色生活」，開放予全港中學生組隊參與，邀請參賽隊伍提交切合主題的創新方案，改善目標社群的軟技能及社區聯繫網絡。參賽者除可免費參與「真人圖書館」，從大師身上學習，了解科技達人、社創項目代表、過往勝出隊伍的成功秘訣外，獲獎隊伍更可免費參與「義遊本地導賞旅程」，了解社區，擴闊眼界。

The HSBC Hong Kong Community Partnership Programme aims to foster a more inclusive society through district-based community initiatives. In 2022, Voltra has become the coordinator of the SMART Community Hackathon for the first time, focused on building community resilience and aimed to inspire students' creativity in the field of innovation and technology and assist different communities to develop technical and soft skills. The competition was divided into three categories: "Future Skills", "Health" and "Green Living". It was open to teams of secondary school students, inviting them to submit innovative solutions to improve soft skills and community networks. Competitors participate in "Human Library" for free to learn from experts and understand the success stories of tech-savvy individuals, social innovation project representatives and previous winning teams. The winning teams had the opportunity to join VolTra Local Guided Tour for free, expanding their horizons and gaining insights into the community."

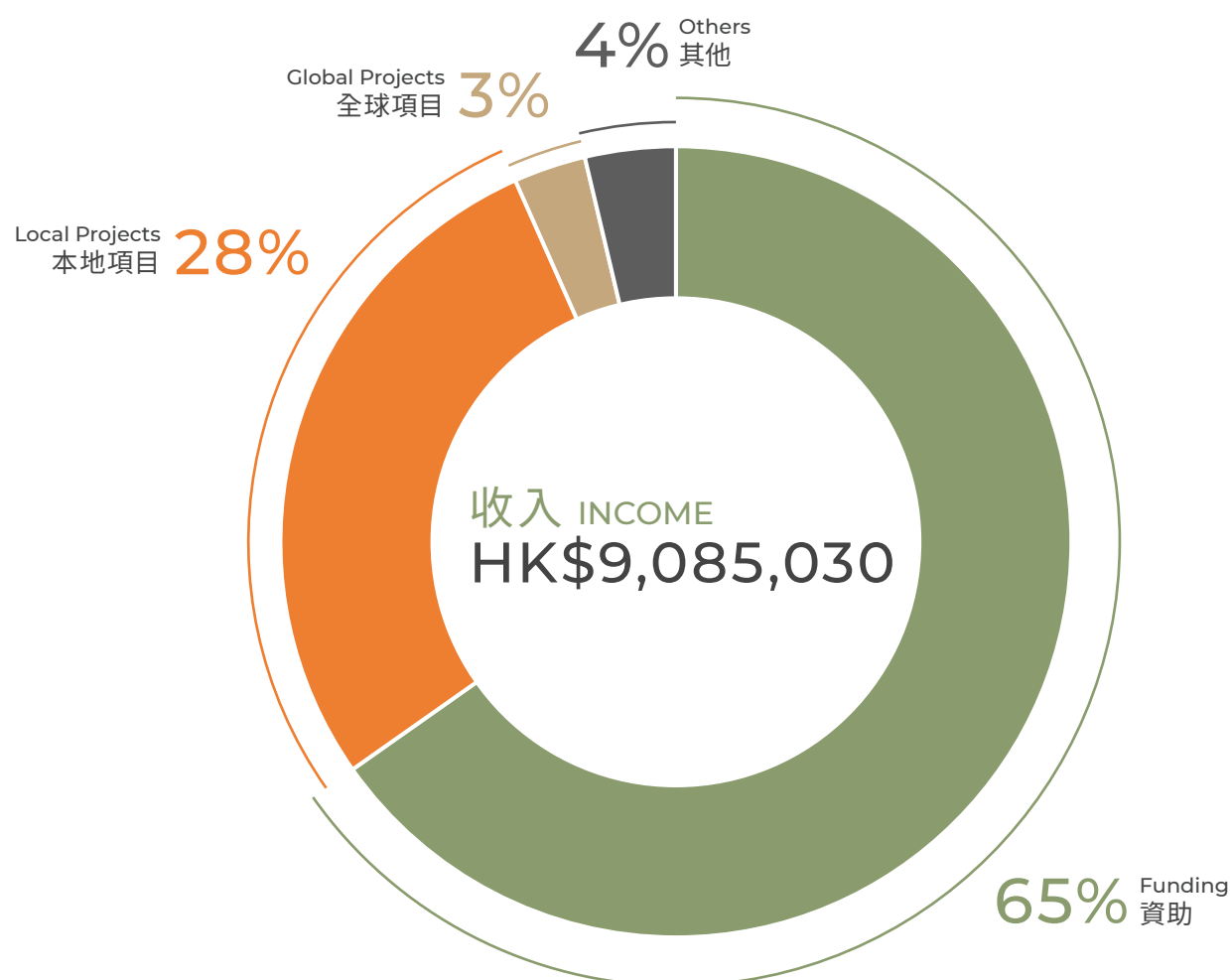

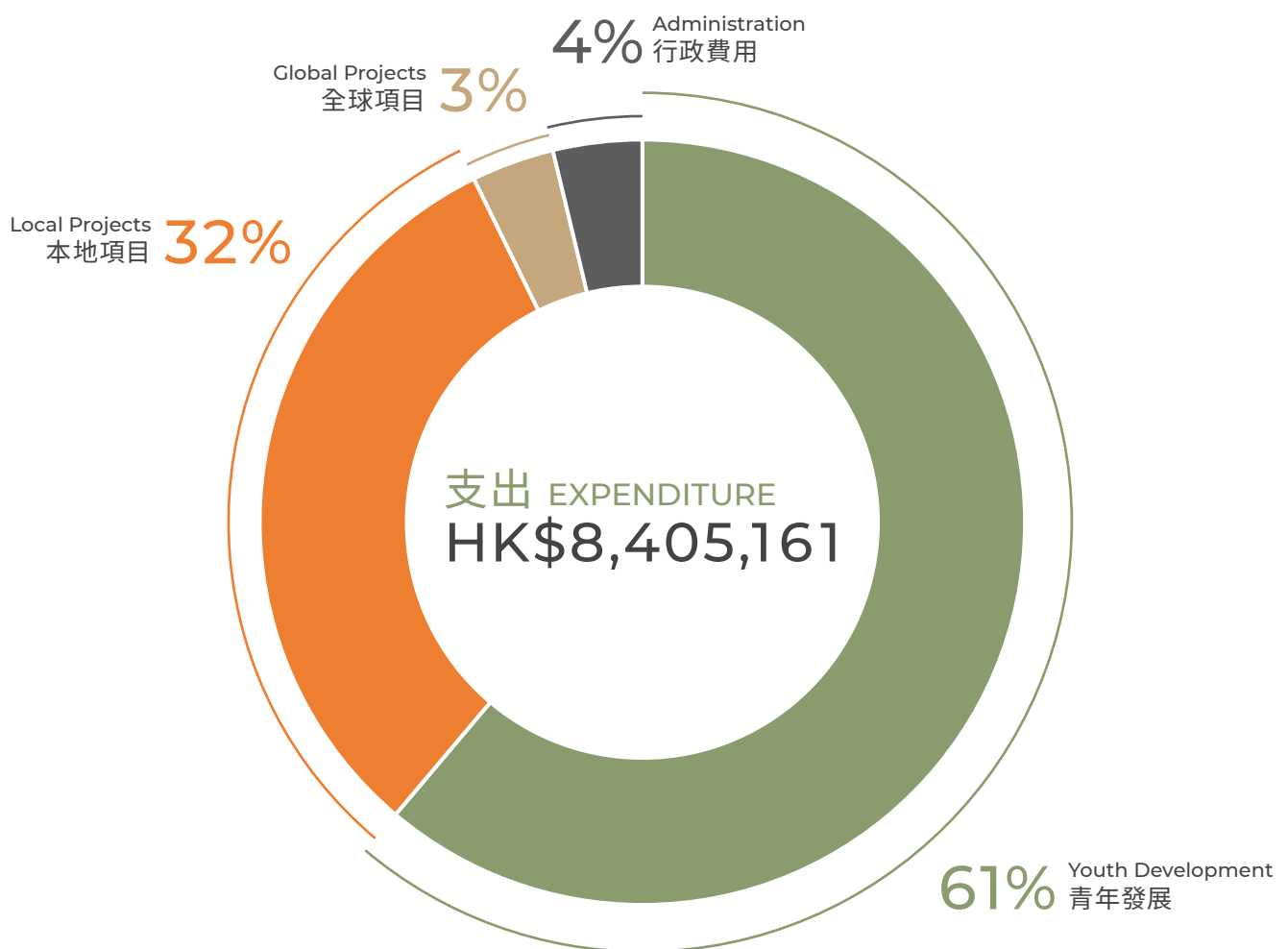
